## THE REQUEST:

Create a custom "2001 Space Odyssey" package to be auctioned during Robin Hood's annual benefit.

## THE PROPOSAL:

Incredible Adventures agreed to provide the high-bidder with a flight 80,000 feet high to the edge of space in a Russian MiG-25, followed by a zero-gravity adventure in the Russian Space Agency's weightless plane, five-star hotel accommodations and lunch with a cosmonaut.

Robin Hood arranged to add round trip air travel to Moscow aboard Delta Air Lines and a behind-the-scenes tour of the Kennedy Space Center led by Hall of Fame Astronaut Colonel Frank Borman.

THE RESULT: Package raised \$280,000.
