NO EVEREST SKYDIVE PARTICIPANTS OR STAFF INVOLVED IN YETI AIRLINES FATAL ACCIDENT AT TENZING HILLARY AIRPORT, LUKLA, TODAY

Following the tragic news of a fatal accident at Tenzing Hillary Airport, Lukla, today, High & Wild can confirm that no-one involved in Everest Skydive was involved. Once the team based at Syangboche heard the news High & Wild immediately offered its helicopter services which were accepted. The company also offered its doctors. All parachuting operations were ceased in respect of those who died and a minute's silence was held. Lukla airport is now closed, but expected to reopen tomorrow. High & Wild will be getting returning clients back to Kathmandu once Lukla has reopened or via helicopter in the mean time.
