



# LUCKY !\* &# WARBIRD ADVENTURE

**The Adventure:** Here's your chance to travel back in time to WWII. Strap on a parachute, put on your helmet and goggles and take the controls of a historic North American SNJ-4 warbird. Even with no prior experience, you'll enjoy loops and rolls in one of the favorite aircraft flown

by Navy, Marine and Air Corps fighter pilots during World War II.

You'll receive:

- A full hour of flying, including aerobatics, in the SNJ-4
- A custom-sewn genuine military A2 leather flight jacket
- A souvenir t-shirt

**The Cost:** \$1075...possibly a little more. (A slight fuel surcharge may become necessary.)

**The Location:** Flights depart from Montgomery Field in San Diego, California.

**The Aircraft:** A Great Warbird is a Great Warbird by Any Name

Called the SNJ by the Navy and Marines, the AT-6 "Texan" by the Army Air Corps and USAF and the Harvard by Canadians and Brits, the aircraft was known by all as "the pilot maker" because of its important role in preparing WWII pilots for combat. Of the more than 17,000 built by North American, only about 350 are still flying today. The SNJ features a greenhouse canopy, tandem seating, dual-stick controls, four-point harnesses, parachutes and a tailhook for carrier landings. It's also big, noisy and nimble.

**Are there any restrictions?** The SNJ is a big, tough bird. The only age and physical requirements are being able to climb into the plane and see out of the cockpit. (That said, if you're taller than 6'8" or weigh more than 350 lbs, this isn't the plane for you.) Flights can be as energetic or smooth as you want.

**Can I give this as a gift?** Certainly! Many people do. If you want the lucky "!@\*!" in your life to get the leather jacket before his or her big day, please allow up to 4 weeks for its delivery.

**How does scheduling work?** When you pay your money, you receive a flight ticket and the top secret phone number you'll need to call to reserve your warbird adventure. Tickets are valid for six months from date of purchase. Our planes fly 7 days a week. Advance reservations are required. If you don't show up for your scheduled flight, you'll make us mad and we'll keep your money.

**Is it safe?** Nothing is more important to us than your safety (or ours, for that matter). We have a perfect safety record and we intend to keep it that way. But, we cannot guarantee 100% safety because everything in life has some risk associated with it. Ultimately, you have to decide what risks are acceptable.
