COSTA RICAN SPRING BREAK ADVENTURE—A SPECOPS OFFERING

This high-action adventure includes daily breakfast, and several other meals, hotels, in-country transport, bungee jumping, white water rafting, "Zip Line" canopy tour, and soaks in a natural hot springs at the foot of the active Arenal Volcano.

Day 1 -(Sat) - San Jose

You'll be transported from the airport to a downtown hotel and have the rest of the day free to lounge by the pool or go shopping or exploring.

Day 2 -(Sun) Sarapiquí River

After breakfast, the Group heads northwest to the Lake Arenal Region. Here you will take your first adventure, a class II/III white water rafting trip down the Sarapiquí River. This will be a 1/2 day trip with lunch included. On the agenda for the evening is a Costa Rica orientation and welcome party.



Day 3 (Mon) - Jungle Adventure

Visit to the Indigenous Maleku Indian tribe, walk with the Shaman to learn about medicinal plants and experience a cultural fire ceremony.

Day 4 -(Tue) - Canopy Tour - half-day tour.



Swing like monkey through the canopy, evening volcano hike to the base of Arenal Volcano and thermal hot springs with volcano view.

Day 5 -(Wed) - Bungee jump, Evening Salsa Lessons

Bungee jump off the Naranjo Bridge. (Are you ready for a 150 ft free fall?) You'll have the afternoon free to go exploring or sign up for an optional horseback ride through the rainforest. In the evening, there will be Salsa Lessons at the local "Disco"... yes, they really call them that in Costa Rica.

Day 6 (Thur) - San Jose

Return to San Jose. The night is free to do some last minute shopping, dinner is next door at a Denny's restaurant. (Yes, a real Denny's)
