



The Wing Nut - An Incredible Adventure for Two

Start your adventure with a 60 minute biplane ride for two. You decide if the ride is gentle or thrilling. Next, you'll both strap into your own VG-21 "Varga" for an air battle in the skies over the Pacific, just like you've seen in the movies and on TV. Then, you'll each take the controls of a big North American SNJ-4 "Texan" and fly loops and rolls.

Bring your wife, your son, your girlfriend, your boss, your best friend, your cousin, your grandmother or anyone. This unique program allows you to share the fun.

The WingNut Flying Adventure for Two includes:

- One 60 minute Biplane ride to share
- Air combat mission for two
- Two 60 minute warbird flights
- Certificate of flight for each flight
- One warbird WWII training manual to share
- 1 Biplane, 1 Air Combat, 1 Warbird T-shirt
- 1 Biplane, 1 Air Combat, 1 Warbird cap

Note: All this excitement can be a bit much for one day, so we suggest you schedule your flights over two days, or more if you live in Southern California or visit often. You have six months to complete your flights.

Flights depart from Palomar Airport in Carlsbad, California. The airport is located less than one hour from downtown San Diego and is approximately 2 1/2 hours from Los Angeles Airport.



Travel Air 4000 Open Cockpit Biplane

Of the 1400 built between 1924 and 1930, only about 50 are still around today (mostly in museums) and we fly two of them. They feature side-by-side seating for two in the front (pilot sits in the rear). Real flying like it used to be, complete with helmet and goggles.



Varga VG-21 "Kachina"

The Air Combat portion of your adventure will take place in the Varga. The planes feature tandem seating and joystick controls and offer excellent climbing and turning performance... and you'll do the flying.



Marine Corps North American SNJ-4 "Texan"

Fly in our warbird—it's a Texan, SNJ, T-6 or Harvard, depending on where you're from and what service you like best. Designed as an advanced trainer for the fighter pilots of WWII and flown by the Air Corps, Navy and Marines, she's a big, loud handful of what the glory years of aviation were all about. Take the controls and fly loops and rolls. No pilot's license is required.
