The Zero-G Russia Adventure A Sample Itinerary

Day One: Arrive Moscow. Spend the rest of the day relaxing or exploring.

Day Two: Spend the early part of the day seeing the great city of Moscow. In the afternoon, you'll depart your hotel for the Yuri Gagarin Cosmonaut Training Center. After a brief tour of Star City and a peek at some of the equipment used by cosmonauts to train for space, you'll meet with the doctor for your final medical check and be trained in flight safety procedures by the Space Agency's expert staff. You'll be back at your hotel in time for dinner or a trip to the theatre.

Day Three: You'll depart your hotel early for the airstrip. Your incredible weightless flight will be followed by a celebration lunch.

Day Four: This is your flight back-up day. We can put a man on the space station, but we still cannot control the weather and a few other things.

More Space

Russia uses a specially-modified Ilyushin-76 cargo plane for its weightless flights. The IL-76 MDK is known for its huge interior. Since we take only 15 participants per flight and it's a very big plane, you'll have lots of room to float, fly and maneuver without gravity. We've gotta warn you though. It's not a pretty plane and it wasn't designed for passenger comfort. This is the real plane used by real cosmonauts preparing for real space flights. You could end up floating along side an astronaut from NASA or a cosmonaut preparing for a trip to the International Space Station.

More Incredible Space Adventures

Make your space adventure even more incredible. Add hands-on training in some of Star City's simulators, including the centrifuge and hydrolab, or add on a jet flight to the edge of space in a Russian MiG-31. Zero-gravity flights can be purchased alone or as part of packages including hotel, tours and more. Private charters are also available.

Important Adventure Notes

Space isn't for everyone. You will be required to provide proof of good health before being permitted to go weightless in Russia. You must also be at least 16 years of age and must sign a Release of Liability.

Because your training and flight will take place within the grounds of a real government space facility, you will need security clearance to fly. We can help you to obtain clearance, but it takes time. It is best to plan your space adventure 45-60 days in advance.
