Questions & Answers

Are parabolic flights safe? There are risks to everything. That said, safety is ZERO-G's number one priority. NASA, the Department of Defense and the Russian Space Agency have performed parabolic flights for 45 years without incident.

What about insurance? ZERO-G flights are fully insured, just like every other commercial airline. Because ZERO-G operates under FAA guidelines, your individual life insurance is valid.

What are the age requirements? Currently, the minimum age to fly is 12. There is no maximum age.

What can I really do in 30 seconds? You'll be surprised! Thirty seconds is a lot of time in zero-gravity. (It's about the same amount of time it takes to bungee jump.) With multiple parabolas, you'll have plenty of time to fly through the cabin like Superman and practice a variety of zero-g maneuvers.

Will I get pictures? Yes. Someone from ZERO-G will provide you with photos and video of your incredible space adventure.

Your Space Plane - GForce One



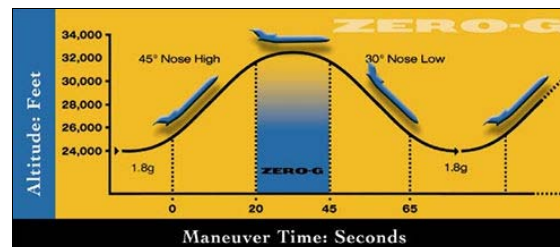
Astronauts and cosmonauts prepare for space missions by training in specially-modified cargo aircraft designed to help simulate the weightlessness of outer space. NASA has used the KC-135 and Russia uses an IL-76.

Your incredible Zero-G adventure takes place on-board a specially-modified and FAA-certified Boeing 727. Flights take off from Florida's Kennedy Space Center and in Las Vegas from McCarran International Airport.

During take-off and landing, you'll sit, buckled into a typical airplane seat. Once the appropriate altitude and destination has been reached, you'll be instructed to leave your seat and position yourself on the padded floor of the plane. Nothing we say can prepare you for what happens next.

Pilots perform a series of parabolic flight maneuvers that counter the forces of gravity and leave you flying and floating about the cabin.

It's an incredible space adventure.
