## Frequently Asked Questions

**Do I need a driver's license to experience a Hard Hat Adventure?** No. Every Hard Hat Adventure begins with classroom training and a detailed safety briefing from a member of our "sandbox team". You'll then be equipped with a hands-free radio, allowing you to communicate easily with one of our expert driving instructors the entire time you're at the controls of one of our big machines. For added safety, each piece of heavy equipment has been equipped with an emergency remote shut-off device, allowing an instructor to quickly turn off the engine if necessary.

**What kind of equipment is available?** The Extreme Sandbox is home to a Caterpillar 315 Excavator, a Caterpillar D4 Bulldozer and a Caterpillar 247 Skid Steer.

**Is there an age requirement?** Yes. Equipment operators must be at least 14 years old. Anyone under age 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the required Release of Liability and present during the adventure.

**What should I wear?** Jeans or other durable clothing is recommended. Closed-toed shoes are mandatory for safety reasons. The bulldozer, excavator and skid steer have climate-controlled enclosed cabs that can be adjusted by the operator for comfort. (That's another way of saying the machines all have air-conditioning and heat.) Your Hard Hat Adventure takes place in a "sandbox" so expect to get a little dirty.

**Is weather a concern?** No and yes. Hard Hat Adventures are available all year long; rain or shine or snow. Thanks to the enclosed cabs, equipment operators stay dry and comfortable in any conditions. Weather could impact your travel to Hastings. That's why we recommend the purchase of adventure travel insurance to guard against cancelled airline flights and other unexpected events.

**Where exactly is Hastings, Minnesota?** Hastings is a suburb of the Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St Paul. Hastings is 30 minutes southeast of Minneapolis St Paul Airport (MSP), at the junction of the St Croix and Mississippi Rivers.

**What else should I know?** Advance reservations are necessary. Hard Hat Adventures are available seven days a week, all year long. Individual programs are generally scheduled on weekends, with weekdays typically saved for corporate and group events. Other Hard Hat Adventure options are available. Call for details.
